## Residency Benefits

### COMPENSATION

PGY1 residents are dual employees of SJCHS and the University of Georgia. Residents are paid a stipend of at least\* \$46,000 for the 52-week residency year. PGY2's are paid at a higher stipend rate.

### HEALTHCARE

Participation in health, dental and vision insurance benefits is an option available to the resident. Residents must complete physical and health screening examinations prior to starting the residency year.

### TRAVEL

Residents are provided a travel allowance to cover expenses of attending required professional meetings/seminars to include the Southeastern Residency Conference (SERC) and the Spring Georgia Society of Health System Pharmacists (GSHP) statewide meeting. All residents attend ASHP Midyear and may attend regional showcases during the year.

## Application Process

St. Joseph's/Candler PGY1 and PGY2 residency programs participate in the ASHP Resident National Match Program. Prospective residents must be registered for the Match in order to apply.

The ASHP Pharmacy Online Centralized Application Service (PhORCAS) is the preferred application route and paper applications via email or regular mail will not be accepted.

Interviews are an integral part of our evaluation and an on-site interview in Savannah will be required for candidates selected to move forward in the application process.

The deadline for receipt of application materials by St. Joseph's/Candler, including transcripts and letters of recommendation, is January 4th for the PGY1 program and the PGY2 programs.
